While constant monitoring and evaluation will be performed by the focal persons with the assistance of day care service parent groups and supervision of the MSWD so as to observe the quality standards and accreditation of center-based ECCD programs.

Part of the implementation of RA 6972 is to ensure the quality in the delivery of the Day Care Service is the standardization of Day Care Center operation and this is done through accreditation process of Day Care Workers and Day Care Centers.

Another thing, the State declared some policies and programs to afford the children utmost protection, best care and proper nutrition at the family and community levels. This has been DSWD's contribution to the Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) program of the government in the past years.
