It shall be the policy of the state to protect and rehabilitee children gravely threatened or endangered by circumstances which affect or will affect their survival and normal development and over which they have no control.

Consistent with the principle of First Call for Children as enunciated in the United Nations Convention of the Right of the Child. Every effort shall be exerted to promote the welfare of children and enhance their opportunities for a useful and happy life.
