A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REVISED/REPROGRAMMED 20% DEVELOPMENT FUND CY 2021 AMOUNTING TO THREE MILLION PESOS (PHP3,000,000.00) WHICH WAS APPROVED BY MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (MDC) THROUGH RESOLUTION NO. 02-2021

WHEREAS, as mandated by Republic Act 7160, the Municipal Development Council (MDC) is tasked to study, formulate and adopt Development Plans, Programs and Activities for every locality, to uplift the social, economic and political well-being of its community, addressing concerns specifically on poverty reduction, unemployment and propel economic growth;

WHEREAS, MDC was convened to discuss the Revision/Reprogramming of 20% Development Fund CY 2021 amounting To Three Million Pesos (Php3,000,000.00) intended for the Projects of Barangay Poblacion, Barangay Canicanian and Barangay Sabang;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Development Council (MDC) through its Resolution No. 02-2021, recommends that the Revised/Reprogrammed 20% Development Fund CY 2021 of the Municipality of Polillo, amounting to Three Million Pesos (Php3,000,000.00) be approved by the Sangguniang Bayan;
