RESOLUTION NO. 012-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, ENGR. CRISTINA E. BOSQUE TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A TRIPARTITE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) BY AND AMONG THE MUNICIPALITY OF POLILLO, PROVINCE OF QUEZON, THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH) AND MARIA NICOLE G. DENOLO, MD, RELATIVE TO THE DOH-DOCTORS TO THE BARRIOS (DTTB) PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991, states that the functions and responsibilities for the delivery of basic health services and other related facilities have been transferred from the DOH to the LGU;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11223, otherwise known as the Universal Health Care Act, states that LGUs shall implement incremental creation of positions to hire the required health care professional and health care worker based on standars, as determined by the DOH, provided, that in the interim, LGUs that are unable to achieve the standards for health care professional and health care worker are eligible to receive deployment augmentation from the National Health Worforce Support System;

WHEREAS, the LGU, considered as one of the doctorless municipalities in the Philippines by ther DOH, is in dire need of physician who will assist the LGU in improving its local health system performance;

WHEREAS, the DOH implements the Human Resource for Health (HRH) Development Program to promote access to quality health services to the marginalized, vulnerable and disadvanged population of the country, to improve health outcomes and to contribute to the attinment of heralth-related Sustainable Development Goals (SGDs);
