* The Sustainable Livelihood Program (SLP) is a capability building program for poor, vulnerable and marginalized households and communities to help socio-economic improve their conditions through accessing and acquiring necessary assets to engage in maintain thriving livelihoods. and Program started year 2013 as Self Employment Assistance Kaunlaran or SEA-K with 9 associations, on year 2014 additional 7 SEA-K Association was organized. And from SEA-K it will reformed into Sustainable Livelihood Program or SLP with additional 37 Associations are organized as group project and from that year up to present, a total of 53 Associations are implemented (2015 - 8 Associations, 2016 - 11 Associations and 2018 - 18 Associations). Last year 2020, Sustainable Livelihood Program funded 42 additional beneficiaries for their individual project in different Barangays.

* The program conducted some capability building activities like financial and business management and organizational development (TEAM BUILDING) that to enhance their skills in terms of running a business/livelihood.
